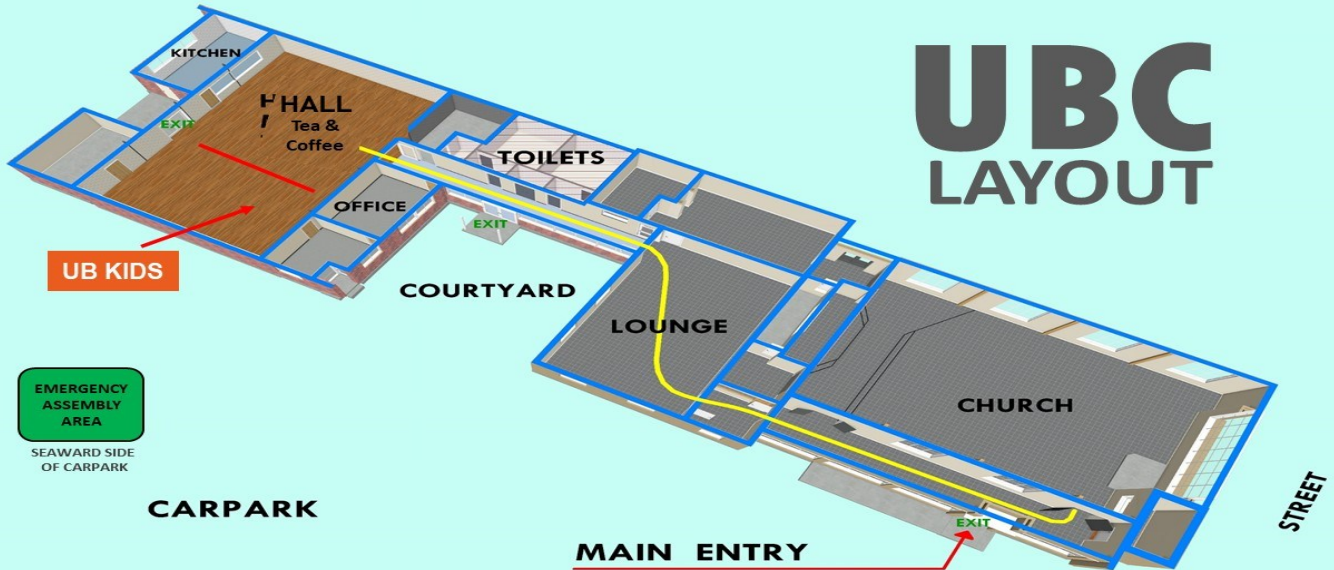
Welcome to Uverstone Baptist

iGive Is Here!

A couple of meetings ago I announced that we would be adding a new electronic giving platform to our new church website. I'm pleased to announce that it is now available (and it works as I tested it :). iGive is a free facility (for tithes) provided by Baptist Financial Services and is an alternative to normal internet banking. The two new features of iGive over internet banking are that it is 100% anonymous, and you can give from a Credit Card as well as normal bank accounts. For those who use either iGive or internet banking, and want to put a giving acknowledgment into the offering bag on a Sunday, we soon will have some BFS "electronic tokens" (small cards) available. I encourage you to have a look at our new website (just type **ub.church** into your web browser), test out the features, listen to a podcast and check out the latest UB News. 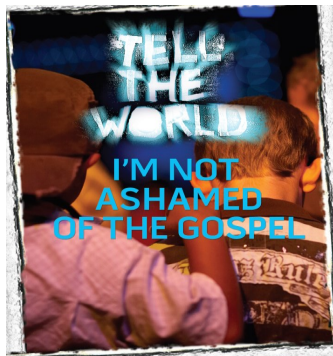
