## Tasmanian Healing Training Schools

Worldview College, Launceston Thurs 19th March (6.30pm) to Sun 22nd March (6pm), 2020 School commences on Thurs 19<sup>th</sup> @8.45am for advanced training for those attending 3<sup>rd</sup>+ school

Walking in **victory** and wholeness is intended for **every Christian believer**, but many struggle to make this a **reality** in their walk. How do we pray for someone who has experienced abuse and receive healing ourselves?

How do we pray for someone who is struggling with life controlling patterns? - How do we pray effectively into trauma, unforgiveness, or a broken heart? **VMTC** (Victorious Ministry Through Christ) provides **teaching** and **practical sessions** on healing, dealing with sin, bondages, destructive patterns, hurtful relationships and traumatic experiences.

Your Training Includes: Teaching & notes on healing from brokenness, bondages and the effects of trauma & hurtful relationships. Your own confidential prayer ministry appointment Participation in Prayer Vigils Basic training in how to minister healing A commitment to attend all sessions is a condition of enrolment

**Costs:** A \$60 registration fee is payable when we acknowledge receipt of your application. Another fee of \$90 to cover meals & venue costs (no accommodation) will be required to be paid no later than 2 weeks before school.

On-site accommodation in shared units available @ \$30-00 per person, per night Unit availability is limited and must be booked in advance and paid for 2 weeks before school. You will need to provide own breakfast - units contain kitchenette.

The Church Leadership Team is keen for our church family to be kept up to date with these changes & in doing so has placed copies on the church notice boards, hard copies in the church Sunway & on the UBC Website. Electronic copies are available from Church Secretary Betty Walsh for those wishing to access this format.

Now having our own Church Safe Policy in place further reinforces the need for all our church volunteers (working with children and / or vulnerable people) to have their own personal Volunteer Agreement's in place.




