Yes, you heard me correctly - we are planning our start up Sunday service for July 26th

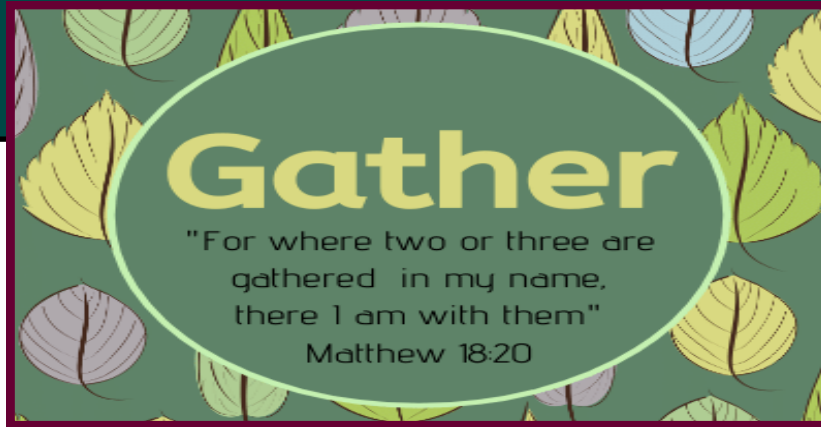
There will be a number of changes to our known regular service format. So stay tuned for more information.

Ulverstone Primary School are forming a new mentoring program for small groups of students who have identified high levels of worry. They are looking for volunteers who are willing to come alongside a group of 3-4 students (with a staff person involved at all times), engage in an activity together and build relationships with students to help them to talk about the things that worry them and how to handle those feelings. The activity could be anything you are interested in (within reason!). Other groups will be doing things like cooking, craft, Lego, ball games, gardening, drawing etc.

It would be a commitment of 1hour a week from 1:30-2:30pm, beginning in Term 3 (from 20th July). You can suggest which afternoon(s) would suit you best. You would need to have a current WWVP card and be ChildSafe trained (or equivalent). We can arrange this training if you don't have it already.
