### What is God saying to you?

#### Part one

As we observe the local, national and international headlines around our world the challenge is: how can we minister in such times into our local community? The world is fast-changing and it is not getting slower. Maybe we should ask, what would Jesus do? What did Jesus do in turbulent times? Firstly, He would make a clear and distinctive statement about the mission. Secondly, we notice that Jesus would seek to gather a team of believers to unite for a common cause. He would build his church in such a way that builds alignment and defines a purpose bigger than we could ever dare to achieve on our own.

Jesus put it this way in Luke 19:10: "The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Jesus had just been criticised for going to the house of a "sinner." Jesus responded by affirming His mission was to save people who needed saving. Their reputation for sinfulness was not a reason to avoid them, rather, it was a reason to seek them out.

Jesus made no secret of his role and purpose, "I have come.... this is the will of my father..." and many more examples in scripture. However, the real question is how we can achieve our day-to-day mission? Essentially, the principle thought here is a process. How do we get from point A to point B? What needs to be communicated? What goals are to be embraced? And lastly, what culture needs to be emphasised? Through this we can identify and assist who we are and how we will action the process into life and ministry at UBC.






