For those of us who read the Bible, God clearly reveals to us his will and purpose for his church. Those of us who have received the love and grace of God and accept God as our Lord and Saviour become a child of God and collectively we form the body of his church. As the body of Gods church, one of the purposes for each of us is to make disciples. Matthew 28 teaches us to *go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.*

Last Sunday morning Nerrelie described how taught beliefs had become so ingrained in her being that it had become difficult for her to see aspects of her faith any other way. Perhaps you, like me were challenged to identify and consider the beliefs or traditions that have become deeply ingrained in us as individuals. What is it for you that prevents the power of the Holy Spirit working in and through you? Acts 1:8 reveals to us..... “⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” Are we preventing the Holy Spirit coming on us through the beliefs and traditions that remain ingrained in us? Are we missing out on experiencing the fullness of the power of God and preventing Gods purposes being fulfilled through us? Are their lost souls in our community missing out on an otherwise fulfilled life and eternity with God because we are unable to witness to them?

We all know how difficult it can be for us to change a habit but changing who we are is the next level and practically impossible without the presence and power of the Holy Spirit.

I'm no longer satisfied with an unfulfilled Christian life. I want to experience the fullness of God in me and I want to see it in you. I want to see the gifts of the Spirit active and working through us. I want to experience an overwhelming level of God's love among us, I want to see us gathering in large numbers for prayer and I want to see God doing miraculous things among us. I want to allow God to cut away all that is in me preventing Him from fulfilling his purposes in me and through me and I want that for you too. There are many encouraging verses for us throughout the Bible however it is the encouragement we give and receive from each other that unites us to strive for more of God together.

This was Paul's prayer for the Ephesian church. May it be our prayer for UBC and the wider church.

Ephesians 3:14-21 ¹⁴For this reason I kneel before the Father, ¹⁵from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name. ¹⁶I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹and to know this love that surpasses knowledge--that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

²⁰Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, ²¹to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

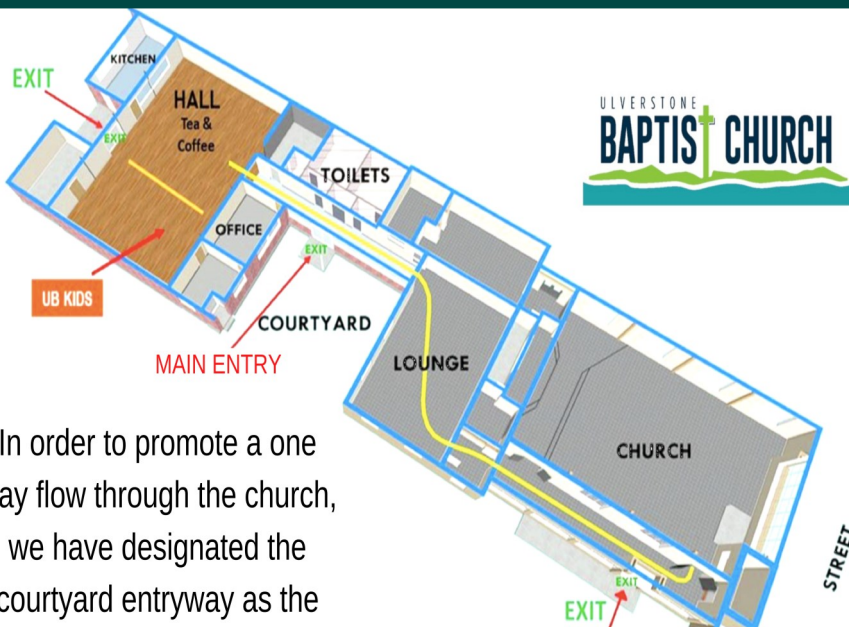

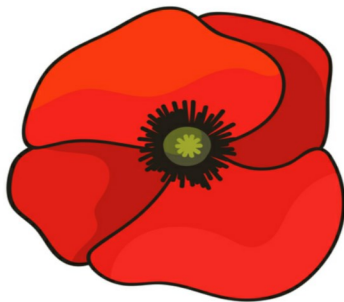

Advocate - keep mission front and centre all year around.

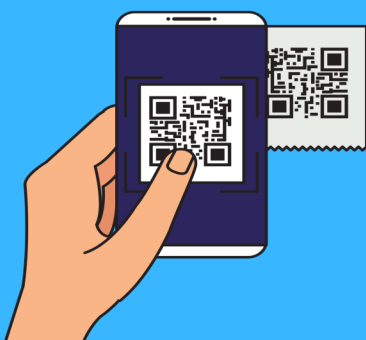

COVID-19 is spreading rapidly right now in Papua New Guinea.

Health resources are severely limited. The government is scrambling to respond. Given PNG's close proximity to northern Australia, this outbreak is also a serious risk to public health in Australia. Australian Aid is providing vaccines. Please pray now!

At the very point when most needed, the **three Baptist hospitals in regional PNG** (Telefomin in the Sandaun Province, Tinsley & and Kompain) may need to close due to a lack of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) for staff. Almost 40,000 people in the region surrounding Tinsley Hospital alone, will be affected unless the hospital receives emergency funds.
