I heard a comment the other day that went something like this, 'where you are is a matter of choice'.

I was reflecting on the message by Graeme on Sunday 18th of July.

Joshua 1:13-16 "Remember the command that Moses the servant of the Lord gave you after he said, 'The Lord your God will give you rest by giving you this land.' 14 Your wives, your children and your livestock may stay in the land that Moses gave you east of the Jordan, but all your fighting men, ready for battle, must cross over ahead of your fellow Israelites. You are to help them 15 until the Lord gives them rest, as he has done for you, and until they too have taken possession of the land the Lord your God is giving them. After that, you may go back and occupy your own land, which Moses the servant of the Lord gave you east of the Jordan toward the sunrise." NIV





Friday 6th August | 10am to 11.20am


Georgia McCall, a physiotherapist from Mt St Vincent Nursing Home is joining us and will be demonstrating appropriate exercises for senior folk.
