We have commenced a series on reimagining. Reimagine is a time to imagine afresh what God can do with us and through us. This is an important time for the church as we continue to build on the right foundation, seek for God to move amongst us and desire His all-embracing, life-changing, all-powerful word to empower us.

Yet [Abraham] did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised. This is why "it was credited to him as righteousness." Romans 4:20-22 NIV

Abraham exercised his living faith, trust and hope in God, and yet he had no prior experience with God. How much more faith should we, who have had the incredible privilege of knowing and walking with God have? Abraham risked it all; he left his hometown and all that was familiar to him. He set out not knowing where he was going but somehow trusted the one leading him; this is awe-inspiring.

May you and I also take up the challenge to trust more than we ever have before. May we become someone who can trust without control, without knowing all the facts, and without knowing what is ahead. That is the real challenge for all of us. While it is a challenge, it may also become an opportunity and a possibility, and that excites me. Faith doesn't drop out of the sky; it is developed and grows as we risk stepping out with God.

Pray for our purpose and mission to become reimagined. But, before this occurs, you have to ask yourself, am I willing to do whatever it takes? Am I willing to follow wherever He leads? How you answer that will determine what God can show you next! That is why reimagining takes us on a journey. It is a pathway for discovery, hope, delight, challenge, uncertainty, and even times of confusion. I encourage you to choose to imagine again or think differently for the season ahead.







WORSHIP

Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you. Psalm 63:3

It's easy to worship through music when you've had a good day, when you're getting along with everyone and when you love the music. So, what do you do with a Sunday service when you're just not "feeling" it? When the music is not to your taste, when someone at church has annoyed you, when your week has been terrible. What then? Elisabeth Elliot said "Worship is an act, and this takes discipline. We are to worship in spirit and in truth. Never mind about the feelings. We are to worship in spite of them." She knew a lot about uncomfortable feelings. Her first husband was killed while trying to make contact with a remote tribe in eastern Ecuador. She then went on to spend time with the tribe who killed her husband; serving God, worshipping, despite her feelings. I'm fairly certain God isn't glorified when we grumble about our circumstances, or pout and fold our arms in stubbornness. He is glorified when we come to Him, surrender ourselves, our feelings, our desires and worship DESPITE our circumstances. Darlene Zschech said "to worship in the light is an act of faith, but to worship in the dark is an act of war." Next time you come to church feeling less than inspired to worship, take a minute and remember Ephesians 6:12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. We're all in a spiritual battle, don't let yourself believe you're passive in this battle, you're active and your act of worship, even when you least feel like it, is a weapon. We're all on the same side, and it's the winning side!
