I wonder if what we have not yet seen has a lot to do with our anticipation and expectation? What if our persistent prayers are firmly focused on asking Jesus to do something NEW! We could pray, 'God, renew me, prepare me, saturate me, fill me, refresh me, help me.' I call this the prayer of renewal! A prayer that leads to action and soul searching.

The Hebrew word renew (hadas) means to renew oneself, repair, and rebuild. The picture of polishing something that has lost its gloss, luster, shine, and reflection (Lamentations 4:1; Colossians 3:12-14).

For something to be renewed it must first start within us. We have all experienced times of difficulty and had moments of trying to understand the why's and how's of different situations and circumstances. Renewal of the heart and mind begins with each of us asking for it. Perhaps even asking the questions; *am I hindered by old mindsets or past experiences? Or, is some unhelpful attitude holding me back?*

Jesus said, "The things which are impossible with men <u>are possible with</u> <u>God."</u> (Matthew 19:26; Luke 18:27). This word 'possible' implies God is able! He is powerful and mighty. It includes the impartation of strength that comes into our soul during difficult, trying and perplexing situations with fortitude and patience.

It's time to allow God to continue to renew us bringing about new life and hope. It is time to dream, believe, be refreshed, and to see His promises again.

Let's be stirred by what we see and what we do not see!







Prayer Focus for November

MIRACLES - DO HAPPEN

And Gideon said unto him, Oh my Lord, if the LORD be with us, why then is all this befallen us? And where be all his miracles which our fathers told us of, saying, Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt? but now the LORD hath forsaken us, and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites. Judges 6:13

Our unlikely focus is Gideon. I love his response. Here is a deep reveal of his heart; he longed for God to move in his heart, home and homeland. The message series on miracles is our response to an almighty all-powerful, loving God and our aspiration to experience God intervening in daily life. For the month of November and beyond, may we each say afresh, with faith-filled hearts, "God, I'm looking to you, I'm leaning on you, I believe in you to lead me, teach me and show me what could be."

We can be drawn to read each weekly focus all at once. But the best way to process our weekly united prayer is to read only one week at a time. Rather than rushing ahead, reflect and ask God to speak to you through the weekly focus.



Prayer Focus for November

Week 1

PRAYER - Gideon said if the Lord be with us.....? Never Give up!

The first challenge is our responsibility to speak out or declare; God, are you with us? It is easy to lose sight of what God is doing when we focus on what it seems like He is not doing. One thing you will notice, Gideon did not consider giving up! Otherwise, the question would not exist in his mind. Because he didn't give up, that reveals the yearning of his heart – Never give up!

Week 2

PROMISE - Why then....

Hold on! God calls us in the middle of our something.

A 'why then' moment can be the trigger for us to be motivated for what is next! In perplexing times of despair, we can hold on even with a small amount of hope. Gideon's frustrations reveal a greater tension or, if you like, desire to change something. Ask yourself what is your why or why then? Better still, what for? What is my heavenly father preparing in this moment or season? I need to see; open my eyes, Lord. And hold on!

Week 3

POTENTIAL -why then is all this befallen us? Opportunity awaits!

It was a dark time for Gideon and his family; the same pressures that seek to silence our faith, hide our hope, and drive our doubt are real today. What you look at - is where you end up! It's difficult to see forward or through something when everything around you may be screaming at you. This is going wrong; that is not happening etc. And yet, this is mostly when the opportunity for God to do something appears. So dream again. Opportunity awaits!

Week 4

POWER - and where are all his miracles our fathers told us of?

I love this, one of my favourite bible verses; why? Because he still believed, he knew in the depth of his heart and soul that God was up for it. It was the thing that got him up in the morning – 'you never know - is this the day?' How important is this hope we possess? To keep believing. In the end, Gideon could see what he couldn't see. His army was reduced against a much larger, almost innumerable army, so any win was God's doing. That is the miracle, the act of God.



WHY ARE WE RIDING?

The quality of education in Egypt is low on the world scale. Teaching styles can sometimes be rigid; pupil participation is not encouraged enough. Many schools have poor infrastructure. Children often fail to properly learn literacy skills and a lack of practice can cause them to fall back into illiteracy. This need is greater than ever, as children have missed out on school and church activities during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Children and Adult Post Literacy project aims to build on newly learnt literary skills in students of all ages and prevent a relapse into illiteracy. This project makes Scriptures available, accessible and affordable to adults and children. Additionally, the project facilitates personal and spiritual development as individuals accept responsibility and take initiative for their ongoing learning.
