NO TURNING BACK.

In Luke chapter four we see Jesus facing off, in temptation, with the devil. Next, He makes this powerful declaration that the Spirit of the Lord is upon Him and that He is anointed to preach, teach, release, heal and deliver in his hometown. We read on a few occasions how the people marvelled at His gracious words and authority (v 22, 32, 36). Immediately after this amazement, He reminded them that when the prophet Elijah was living during a famine, he didn't go to one of Israel's needy widows; instead, he went to a foreigner. This upset those who heard it and they knew full well this was a backhanded statement, they were furious. Meek and mild Jesus didn't mince his words, or at least the meaning behind his words. Time was precious and the kingdom was at hand for everyone, Jew or otherwise. They mobbed Jesus and forced him to an edge of a hill to throw him off. I love this; *He passed right through!* One minute, He is an anointed speaker from God; the next minute - kill him! Jesus escaped and continued with His ministry.

Friends, I share this for a few reasons.

There is a point in life and church when we can't go back. We must embrace with wisdom our future and calling together. We must accept new paths and paradigms of how we do things and trust His leading, even if it is with tension or is not popular.

The other thought is how **the anointing attracts opposition**. When God, through His Spirit, is moving, there is always a sense of undermining. It is a spiritual thing; it is difficult to understand without lots of prayer and intercession. If you are facing off with some spiritual matter, some battle remember; we do not fight against flesh and blood. Put on your armour and speak authority over it in Jesus' name.

The last point is **obedience attracts favour and the supernatural** (He just walked through). When Jesus is present, newness and transformation are always present. At the close of chapter four, he moved on to a new place for ministry and these people begged Jesus not to leave.

May the fresh wind of the Holy Spirit blow into our hearts so that we can be open, refreshed, hungry, expectant, and challenged in preparation for the season ahead.




2023 - 2024 Budget
