



Last Sunday during an amazing and anointed worship time at Chapel Church at Nerang on the Gold Coast, I had some thoughts pop into my head out of the blue which I believe were from the Lord.

He said to use each Monday night at our regular Prayer Gathering, during the month of October to pray specifically for our Church family's needs.

We are going to pray and stand in the gap on behalf of our church family and pray specifically for the pressing needs of those who are willing to share with us what they are praying and believing for.

Some of these prayer needs maybe: reconciliation of family, prodigals coming home to the Lord, salvation of family members, finance difficulties, work difficulties, ongoing Health problems, marriage stresses, youth struggles, relationship breakdowns, battles with different addictions or concerns of elderly family or friends etc.

The best way for you to communicate these prayer needs is by the following;


- 1. Filling out a prayer and praise report card and include your name and the first name or names of the people we are praying for.
- 2. You can also write your request on a piece of paper.
- 3. Or even better, come and join us on a Monday night and we can pray for you and your family personally.

It would be helpful to use their first name when praying for your family member however, it is not necessary as the Lord knows who they are. We understand that they may wish to remain anonymous and that is OK.

I want to stress that whatever you share with us to pray about will be kept in confidence and not spoken about outside of the prayer room.

We will put a box out in the sunway marked PRAYER REQUESTS and for the next few weeks you can drop your notes into it.

We are believing for God to do miracles in answer to our prayers and therefore, in the following months, we and you will have opportunities to bring with thankfulness to God, lots of praise reports of answered prayers - to share and encourage everyone at UBC.



DEDICATION SUNDAY



Empty shoeboxes are available in the sunway.
You will also need a brochure which will include your
label and payment details. This brochure also gives a guide of
what to include and how to pack.

In 2022 15,811 boxes were filled in Tasmania. A 40 foot container (11-12,000) boxes went to Cambodia and the remainder to Fiji.

Most boxes are distributed by the local Evangelical Churches who also run The Greatest Journey Discipleship courses. This 12-week course is offered to many of the children who receive boxes (with their parents' permission). Since this commenced in 2009 over 17.5 million children have decided to follow Jesus Christ during this course.

If you haven't already, consider filling a box to bless a child and give them the opportunity to learn that Jesus loves them. Boxes need to be in no later than the end of October. If anyone would like to financially contribute towards the cost of sending boxes, you can do so by placing your gift in an envelope clearly marked for shoeboxes and place in our black offering box.

We plan to have Dedication Sunday on Sunday 22nd October so, if possible please bring boxes then.


The Ulverstone branch of Bible Society Australia "Festival of Word and Song"

School commences on Fri 3rd @8.45am for advanced training for those attending 3rd+ school

This is a live-out school but an on-site accommodation option is available - see below

VMTC (Victorious Ministry Through Christ) provides **teaching** and **practical sessions** on healing, dealing with sin, bondages, destructive patterns, hurtful relationships and traumatic experiences.

Your Training Includes:

- Teaching & notes on healing from brokenness, bondages and the effects of trauma & hurtful relationships
- Your own confidential prayer ministry appointment
- Participation in Prayer Vigils
- Basic training in how to minister healing

A commitment to attend all sessions is a condition of enrolment

Costs:

A combined fee of \$180 covering registration (\$60) and meals & venue costs (\$120) (but not accommodation) will be required to be paid no later than 2 weeks before school. Please do not pay any fees prior to receiving final confirmation letter.

On-site accommodation in shared units is available @ \$40-00 per person, per night. Unit availability is limited & must be booked in advance & paid 2 weeks before school (with other fees). You will need to provide own breakfast- units contain kitchenette.
