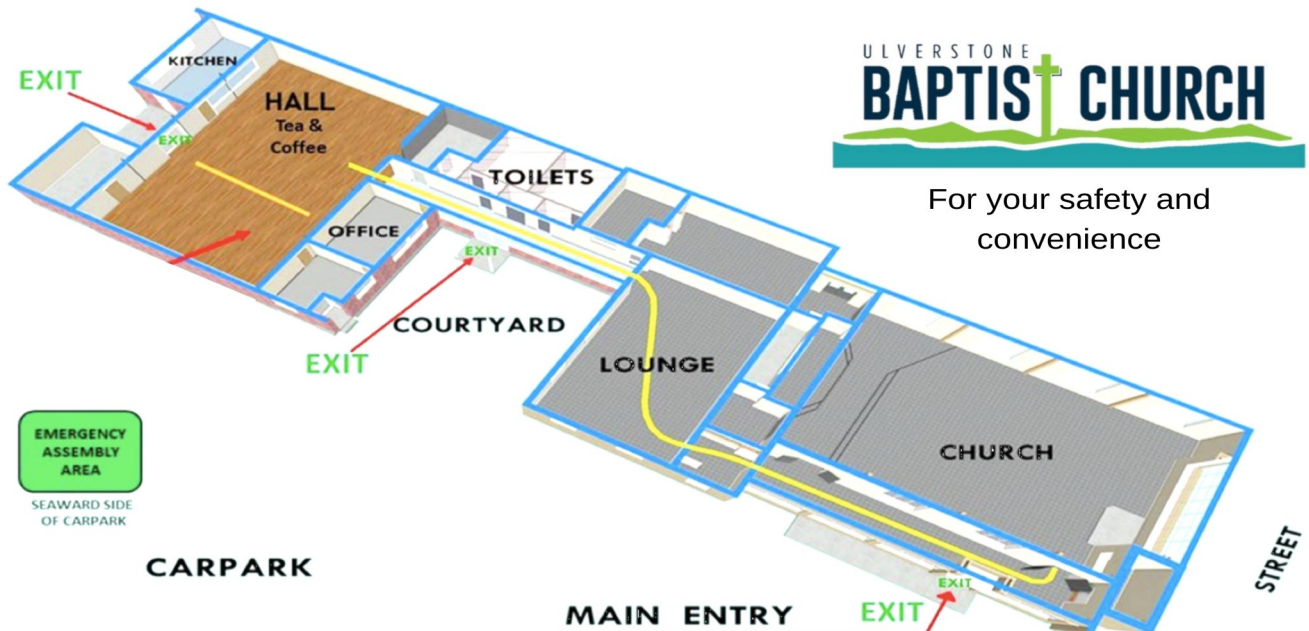

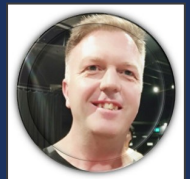

Even More

Friends, I am interested in how Jesus taught His disciples on His way to Gethsemane about being even MORE fruitful and MORE effective.

With this in mind, it makes me question how we can apply this to our own lives and also to our vision and purpose as a church family? I believe that if we are honest enough, UBC has a significant window of opportunity into what God has called us to do, and that includes EVEN MORE!

In John 15:1-2 Jesus says "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be EVEN MORE fruitful.

After a tree is pruned of its dead branches & unproductive limbs, all nutrients are then not wasted on these parts of the tree but can be provided to the healthy parts that can flourish & become more fruitful.

Jesus helps to give us (as his people) a thought-provoking picture of our own fruitfulness. If we are all honest, I am sure the Father has pulled out the hedge clippers a few times with you and me as He begins to cut away unproductive things in our lives. The reason for this is so that we can stay healthy and appealing and flourish. (v2, **he prunes so that it (we) will be even more fruitful**).

I pray that **WE** can grow into **MORE** of what God has called for us at UBC.

Are we ready to step forward with courage and curiosity to become this transformational Church Jesus had in mind?

Walking in **victory** and **wholeness** is **God's heart** for **every Christian believer**.

However for various reasons many struggle to step into God's plan for their lives.

- Have you experienced abuse in the past that still affects your behaviours?
- Do you struggle with fear, shame, doubt & hopelessness?
- Do you struggle with life controlling habit patterns?
- Have you suffered trauma, wounding or rejection which still affects you?

Many Christians give up on finding healing for these and other areas in their lives, accepting them as 'who they are' but **Jesus came to set you free!** – Luke 4:18-19

At a VMTC prayer school you will have your own confidential prayer ministry session through which you can receive His healing power and enter into freedom from these bondages, past traumas and unhealthy habit patterns.

The ministry and training you receive at a VMTC school can help you walk in greater levels of personal healing, wholeness and relationship with God.

It will also teach you how to minister this freedom to yourself and others through a simple pattern of biblically based prayer. Many powerful testimonies of God's healing, deliverance and freedom have come from using this simple practice.

Costs:

Registration \$60 per person (\$100 per couple)

Meals & Accommodation \$300 per person

All main meals, morning & afternoon tea are provided. All accommodation is on "twin share" basis (unless otherwise arranged at extra cost). Limited motel style accommodation available at extra cost. Special dietary requirements are catered for but you must let us know at least 2 weeks in advance.
