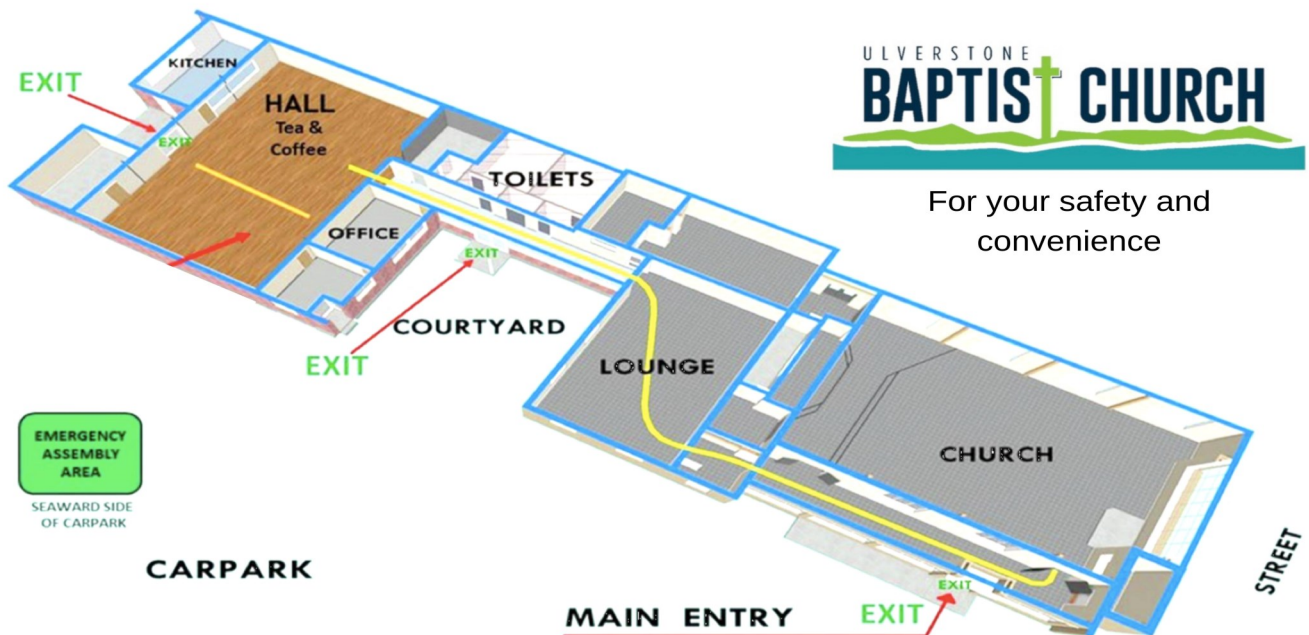

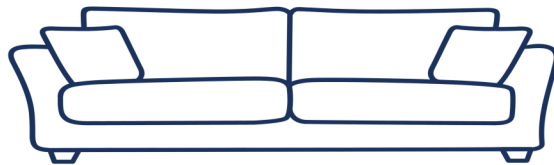

# Living with Loss

## One Day Seminar

For community members and professionals to gain an understanding of mental health and grief-related challenges and learn strategies to support those living with loss.

### *Keynote Speakers and Workshop Presenters:*

#### Bianca Welsh



Bianca Welsh co-owns Stillwater Restaurant and Seven Rooms accommodation in Launceston. She operates her own mental health business - 'From Experience', providing education and advice to workplaces on how to be mentally healthy. Bianca is a Mental Health First Aid Instructor and devoted mum. Bianca lost a son at 37 weeks gestation in January 2022 and her lived experience with mental health, baby loss, grief, PTSD and trauma, means she is a diverse person who's most important values are kindness, honesty and compassion.

#### Tracey Martin-Cole



Tracey Martin-Cole is a Psychologist, Play Therapist (RPT-5), Psychology Board Approved Supervisor, and founder of a large group private practice, Psychology CAFFE, in Tasmania. In 2021 Her team were acknowledged as National Winners of the Paediatric Excellence Award, in recognition of their contribution to changing the lives of children and their families in their local community here in Tasmania. In 2023 Tracey was the state winner of the "Tasmanian Life Awards - Outstanding contribution to Suicide" award, in recognition of the contribution that Psychology CAFFE is making for people and families struggling with suicidal thoughts and outcomes.
