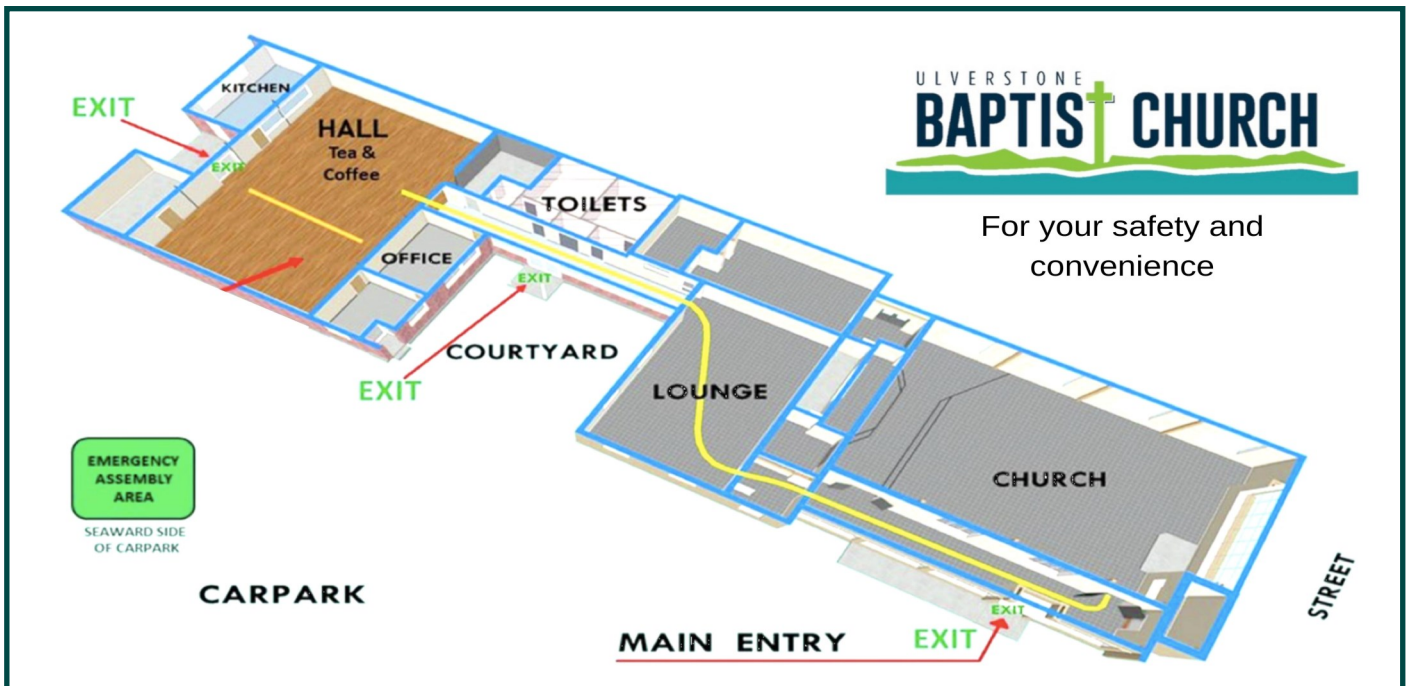





In My Fathers House

I am grateful to have grown up in a home and a church family where God's *Father Heart* was reflected. As a teenager I had my eyes opened to the cruelty possible amongst people by reading Corrie Ten Boom's "The Hiding Place" but at the same time inspired by faith, courage and kindness. Corrie told the story of her family's efforts to hide Jews and others persecuted by Nazi's and their subsequent experiences in concentration camps. She also wrote "In My Father's House" which told the story of Corrie's childhood home and the experiences that shaped her faith. Corrie saw her father and home as a reflection of God's love and provision, a place where people could find refuge and safety. This was a preparation to be ready as a family to minister in very difficult times.

Jesus said in John 14:2 "In My Father's House are many rooms. I am going there to prepare a place for you". Every time we sing "in my Father's House, there's a place for me, I'm a child of God, Yes I am" * I am so thankful that we have that promise not just for the future but for now. As we pray, "Our Father, Holy is your name, Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as in heaven..." may we seek God's Heart for us to be a local expression of our Father's kingdom here in Ulverstone.

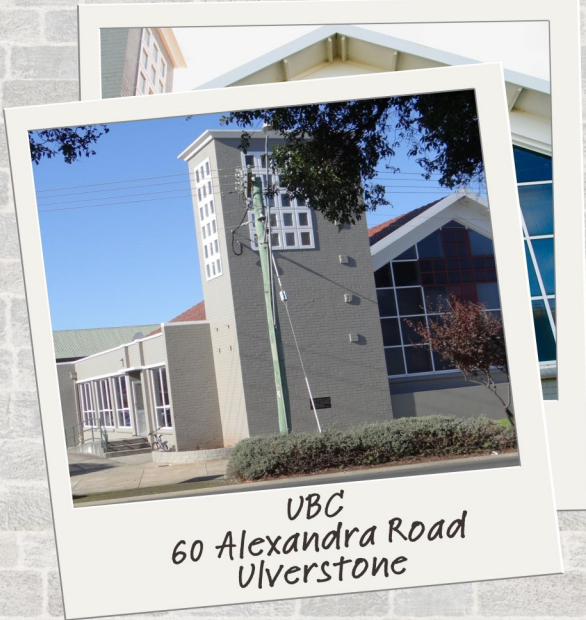

What's the difference between knowing about God and knowing God? Knowing about God is a mind exercise. We can recount stories from scripture, list His attributes and even defend doctrines. But true knowledge of God, the kind that transforms lives and hearts, goes beyond intellectual understanding. It dives deep into personal experience and intimate connection.

God wants us to experience Him personally. Not just to know about Him, but to know Him as our Heavenly Father who loves us deeply. He wants us to encounter Him in a very personal way. 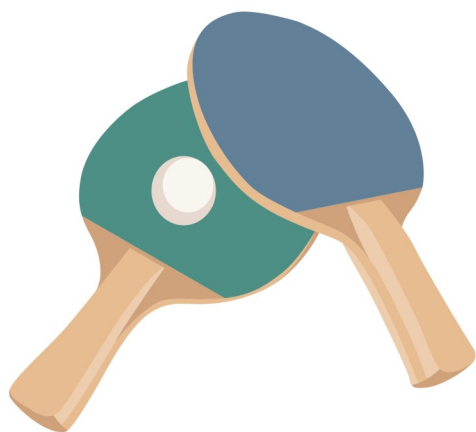

is the ministry name of Peter and Kathryn Yaxley.

Our Heart is to encourage, strengthen and empower the body of Christ, according to Eph 4:12, by providing face to face and online workshops to equip people to go deeper in their walk with the Lord.

Our Ministry began when we met and married while studying at the Bible

College of South Australia. The Lord called us to Tasmania in 2000 and for 15 years we worked in pioneering community outreach, youth and children's work, women's and school's ministry, which included chaplaincy support. All in relationship with a Baptist church, our local Christian Leader's Network, Scripture Union, Fusion and YWAM.

From 2015-2019 we travelled across Australia sharing our written resources and presenting workshops on prayer and Hearing God's Whispers across many denominations and Christian groups.

Now based in Northern Tasmania we continue to offer online and face to face workshops as well as retreats and creative reflective sessions.

Our Resources include practical written material and YouTube clips to empower people to build their connection with God. Kathryn's book and journal, written during Covid, have become the latest offerings.

Her story, *Threads of Hope, Knots of Pain* – details a unique perspective of a journey of suffering. Revisiting the traumatic period of illness and chronic fatigue experienced during her teens Kathryn shares God's whispers in response to her questions as she gleans His perspectives of these same events. The reflective journal, *Explore Your Story* provides a variety of crafted activities to help others engage with their own life journey and position their hearts to listen for God's whispers. Both books and a selection of booklets will be available on the day.
