




Appointment of Church Leaders & Officers for 2024/2025

Costs:

Registration \$60 per person (\$100 per couple)

Accommodation (optional) \$45 per person (\$90 per couple) per night

On-site accommodation in shared units is available. Single accommodation is in shared rooms. Unit availability is limited & must be booked in advance & paid 2 weeks before school (with other fees).

Meals & Venue \$130 per person

Midday and evening meals, morning & afternoon tea are provided. You will need to provide your own breakfast. The onsite units contain a kitchenette. Special dietary requirements are catered – please inform us at time of registration if you have special dietary needs.
