

God had other plans for Moses after he fled and made a new life away from Egypt. He had called Moses from the burning bush to reset his life with the one purpose of living solely for God's work.

What If Moses had said no? Only God knows. Moses had a simple message but a difficult task. Moses had to return to Egypt, meet Pharaoh, and tell him, *"God says: Let my people go so that they can worship me"* (Exodus 9:1).

God knew the breakthrough His people needed. Breakthrough is to identify something blocking you from growth or holding you back from spiritual freedom and fullness of life. Breakthrough in the Bible signifies a significant change or an event that marks the end of a struggle - often described by divine deliverance or intervention.

Today, many people are bound. They are not walking in the fullness of God. Why are we not seeing the miracles of divine intervention daily? As a Christian, these questions weigh heavy on my heart. God's heart is to set you free. In John 8:32 we read; *"You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."*

Friend, allow the authority and truth of God's word to speak deep into your heart. Ask yourself what you need to let go of. What sin, what burden, what pain, what hurt? What is God revealing or showing you? Don't just take my word on this. Romans 6:22 reads; "Now you **have been set free** from sin." In Romans 8:2 we read that, the Holy Spirit will give you life that comes from Christ Jesus and will **set you free** from sin and death. It is Christ who gives Freedom.

Friend, it is time to push through, seek God, and worship him unashamedly in the freedom he has provided. (Galatians 5:1)



After our morning worship service, grab a cuppa and join us back in the auditorium for a 11.30am start.






