


MOTHER'S DAY Diages





We would love to share in these moments with you and pray for your need.



FROM THE PASTOR......

May is May Mission Month. It's a time when all Baptist churches across Australia bring a united focus and pray for the mission of God, but in all truth, the mission is an everyday reality.

We are all on a mission. Mission is the heartbeat of God. May Mission Month is an ideal time to reflect and adjust our own personal missions as it is through us, with help from the Holy Spirit that others will come to know Christ.

What does the call to be a believer in my life look like?

With all seriousness, every believer needs to ask that question . The words Jesus declared, "well done, good and faithful", are uniquely related to that call response. It is here that Jesus was talking about storing treasures in heaven and the parable of the talents. This text is uniquely engaging because only two kinds of people will hear these words. Firstly, only believers will hear these words. Second, only believers who fulfil their calling aligned to Christ will hear these words. I have always taken this passage personally and urgently.

If you are interested in helping others, here are a few areas to focus on.

How can I best share and be a witness the gospel?

How can I help those disadvantaged?

What areas are holding me back?

Who do I need to forgive?

Reflect on any issues such as unforgiveness, offence, hurt, or misunderstanding that may restrict spiritual growth. Seek healing, forgiveness, and guidance to overcome these barriers.


