

Help me to see what I can not see!

Hello friend.

Sometimes it can be easy to miss what God is doing. Let me remind you of the words to a song we sing sometimes in our Sunday morning worship service called Way Maker.

Even when I don't see it, You're workin' Even when I don't feel it, You're workin' You never stop, You never stop workin'

The words to this song challenge me to know that when nothing feels certain, I need to hold onto faith. As a follower of God, faith is our most essential armour. It can also be our most vulnerable, especially when God works in unseen or unexpected ways.

Hebrews 11 is called the "faith chapter." If you're struggling with doubt, fear, or just waiting for breakthrough, let me tell you, you are not alone.


Faith doesn't mean the absence of fear, but the decision to act in trust of God's greater plan does. Faith is what we live by, it holds conviction, and allows us to not be intimidated by the happenings around us.

> By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw that the child was beautiful, and they were not afraid of the king's edict. Hebrews 11:23 ESV

Hebrews 11:23 doesn't immediately sound like a strong faith statement. Moses' parents hid him because he was "beautiful" and didn't fear Pharaoh's command. That seems odd; aren't all babies beautiful? But here's the point: they hid him. Was that faith? Moses' parents acted in faith despite fear. There was real danger. Infants were being killed. Yet they believed God had a purpose for their son. Many people, including parents, carry guilt for feeling fear, but faith often walks beside fear; it just refuses to be ruled by it.

Pray, Lord, help me see what I cannot see. Give me courage, discernment, and boldness to trust in Your plan. Strengthen my faith so that even when I feel fear, I can obey You. In Jesus' name, Amen.





If you consider UBC to be the place you call home then we warmly invite YOU to join us.


After our morning worship service, grab a cuppa and join us back in the auditorium for an 11.30am start.
