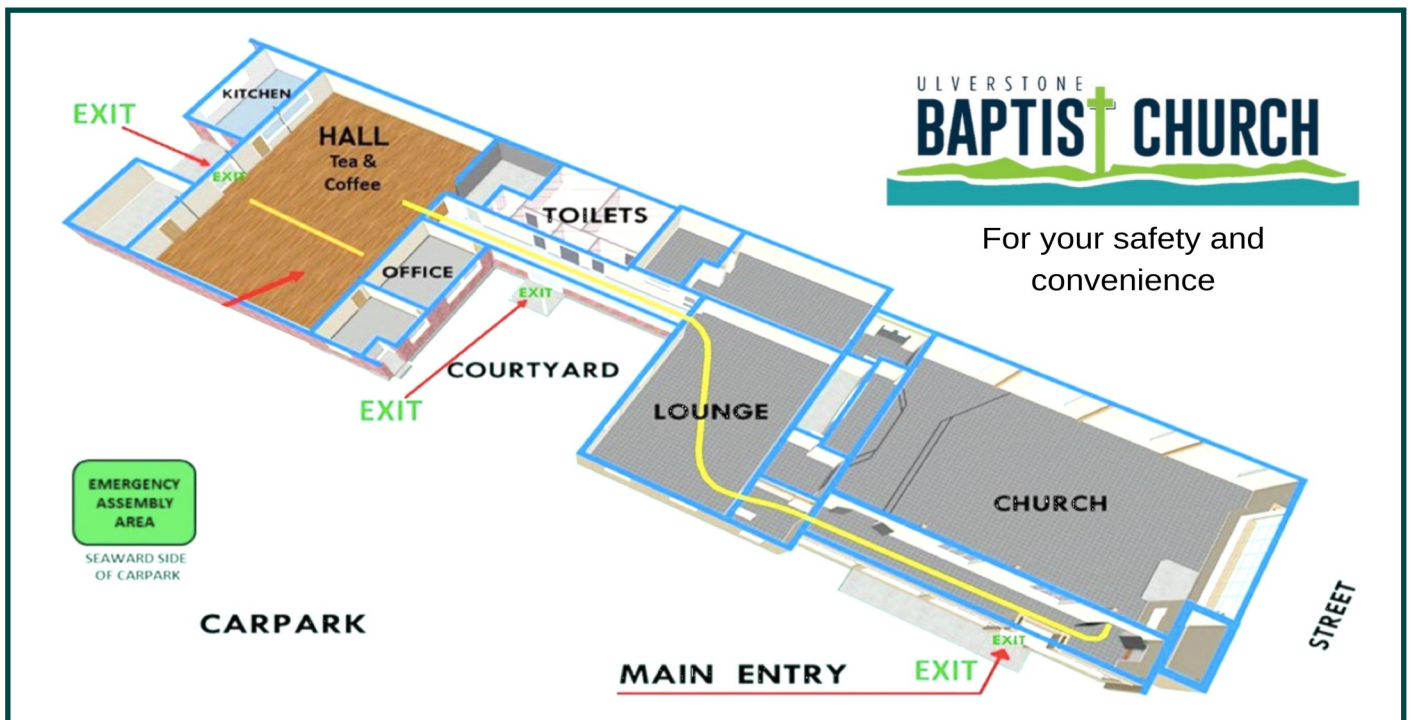

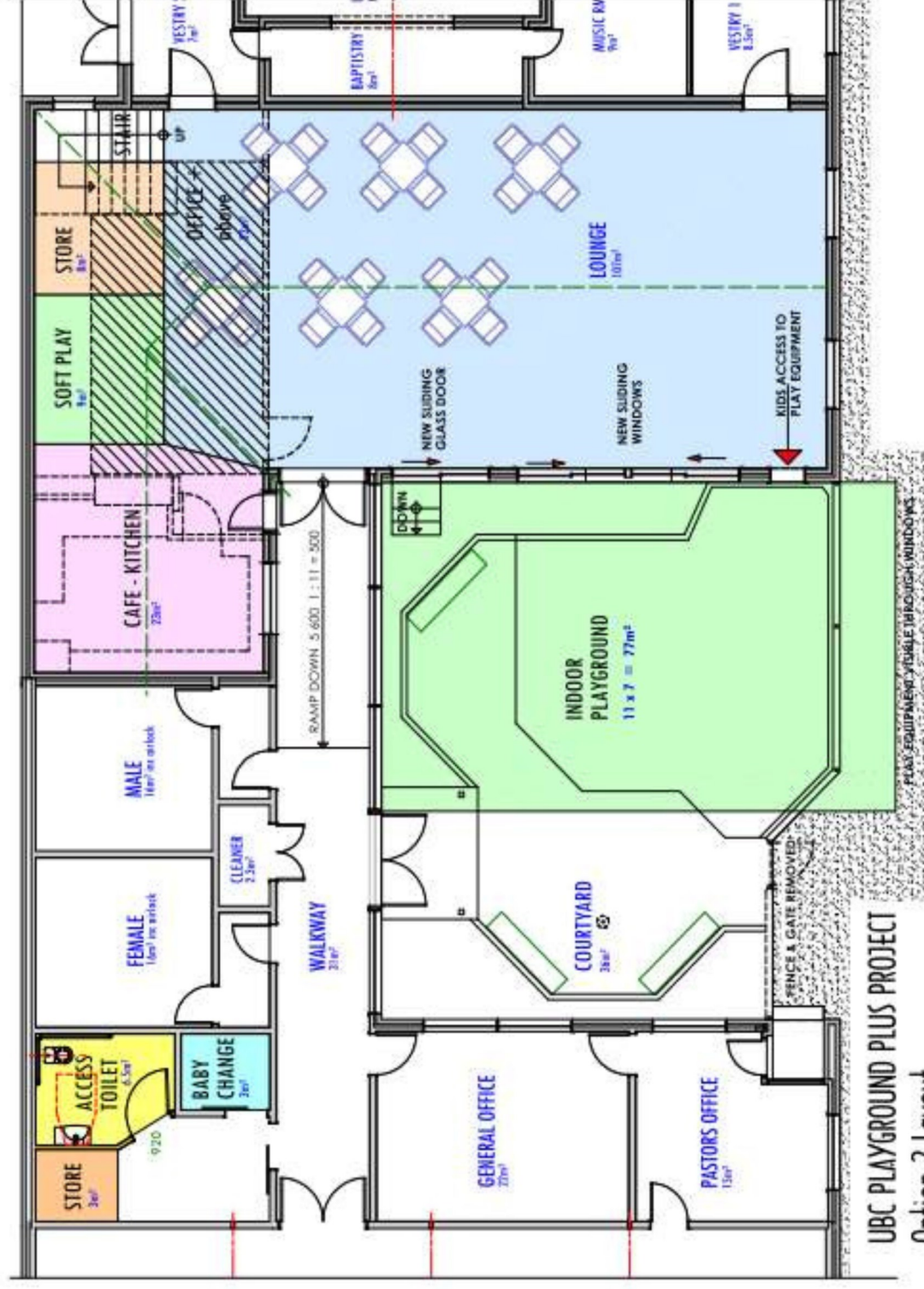

MISSION CONNECTION

Supporting mission, social justice and awareness programs are central to our UBC vision of seeing God change lives through me. We believe mission is within our local community and beyond, and that with prayer and financial support we can make a difference both locally and globally through God's compassion, grace and gospel.



Baptist Mission Australia partners with Australian Baptists to see growing, vibrant faith communities emerge among the least-reached people groups around the world. In May, UBC supports Baptist Mission Australia's May Mission Month. This is an annual event that focuses on global missions and encourages churches to engage with God's work worldwide. It's a time for us to learn about, pray for, and support the organisation's teams and ministry partners.



Baptist World Aid believes that it is God's desire for the world to be without poverty and injustice and work toward ending poverty so all people can enjoy the fullness of life God intends. They encourage and equip the Church, in Australia and globally, to respond to environmental crises that affect our most vulnerable neighbours around the world through disaster response, while pursuing the work of community transformation.

Christmas is a time for coming together and sharing. Each Christmas, UBC takes part in Baptist world Aid's Christmas appeal. This financial gift helps provide families the support they need to change their communities for the better.

For 50 years, Australian Baptists have been transforming lives through Child Sponsorship. Each of us here at UBC have the opportunity to be part of something bigger by impacting generations and supporting a child.



Crossover, founded in 1984 as part of Australian Baptist Ministries, helps Baptists across Australia share the message of Jesus. They offer encouragement, training, and practical resources to support outreach and evangelism, relying on grassroots funding from individuals and churches. Each Easter UBC joins in the Australian Baptist Easter Offering to unite with a thousand Australian churches in expressing our gratitude for Jesus and investing in sharing him with others.



WEC – Worldwide Evangelisation Crusade: WEC Australia is a branch of WEC International.

WEC Australia's mission encompasses two primary objectives. These are, providing support and care for Australian WEC members serving internationally, and assisting believers and their churches in Australia to actively engage in God's mission to reach the unreached. Partnership with churches is key to WEC as their desire is to walk with churches to help engage their members to actively participate in God's mission to the unreached.
