

Printed copies of our 2024/2025 Annual Report are in the sunway (1 per household)



The Creating Safe Spaces Workshop provides training on Safe Church principles and practices for pastors, elders, deacons, ministry leaders, children's/youth leaders/team members, or anyone ministering to vulnerable people.

If you are in a position of leadership or influence and are yet to complete Safe Church training, or have not done it in the last three years, GOOD NEWS! You can do the brand-new training which was developed by New South Wales Baptists and is being adopted around the country.

The participation of church members in this kind of training is taken into account when any claims are made for insurance, but that is not the reason we want all our Tasmanian leaders to be current with this training.

We have all seen what happens when churches are not safe..... and we want to be a movement of churches that are genuinely safe for everyone.

This training only takes 3 hours in person, plus some online training beforehand, which is fairly straightforward. The total cost is \$40.00

The in-person training will be happening at Devonport Baptist church 9 am - 12 pm on Saturday November 22nd.

There is an additional half hour training block after the main sessions for leadership teams and pastors.
