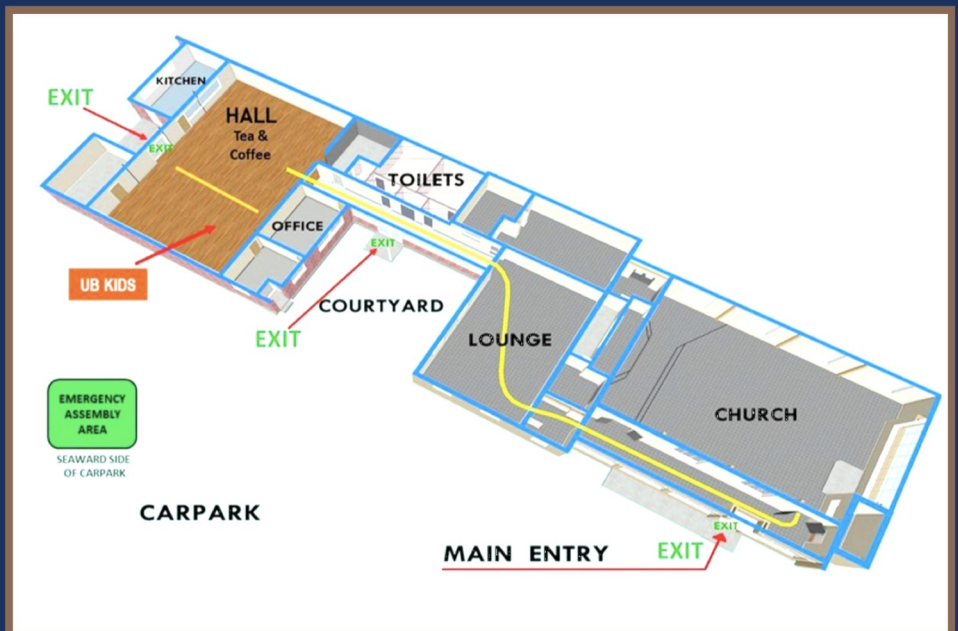
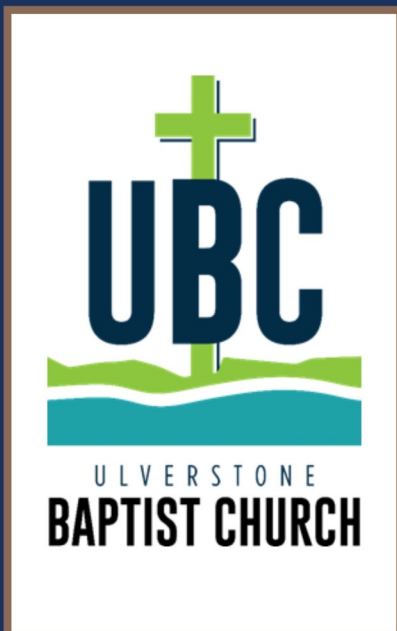

Note that Monday 8th is the King's Birthday public holiday for all Tasmania.

- Have experienced abuse in the past that still affects their behaviours ...
- Struggle with fear, shame, doubt & hopelessness ...

- Have suffered trauma, wounding or rejection which still affects them ...

And so give up on finding healing for these and other areas in their lives, saying "this is who I am" but **Jesus came to set us free!** – Luke 4:18-19

At VMTC:

We aim to bring personal healing and wholeness to each individual through teaching on areas of sin and bondages and God's pathway to freedom. We include a confidential prayer and healing ministry for each individual as well as training and participation in prayer ministry for others. You will also be trained and involved in intercession for others through prayer vigils.

Alternatively:

If you are not able to commit to the whole school the option is available for you to just have your own prayer ministry session during the school (at no cost).

Costs:

Registration **\$70 per person** (\$120 per couple)

Meals & Accommodation **\$330 per person**

All main meals, morning & afternoon tea are provided. Single accommodation is in shared rooms. Special dietary requirements are catered – please inform us at time of registration if you have special dietary needs.
