HOLD YOUR TESTIMONY

In every season, especially the stretching ones, your testimony matters. It's worth repeating again and again. Your testimony is God's story still being written in your life: the victories, the struggles, the wrestles, the places He is still forming in you.

A song I've been listening to, 'Our Testimony' by Bridge Worship, captures this beautifully. It thanks God for the stories in the room, the lives turned around, the miracles seen, and the ones still unfolding. It reminds us that He writes a better story, and that our lives are living proof of His power.

Revelation gives us the deeper backdrop. In chapter 12, the curtain is pulled back, and we see the real battle: an enemy who accuses, intimidates, and works relentlessly to silence the saints. Yet God's people overcome, not by strength, not by strategy, but: "By the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony."

Their victory wasn't passive. It was spoken. Lived. Declared. Held onto.

One of the enemy's oldest tactics is painfully simple: say nothing. Lose your voice. Keep quiet about Christ. Keep quiet about the story God is writing right now. But the Spirit calls us to something better - wisdom, courage, and a faithful witness.

So, UB family, let me encourage you: Hold to the truth. Keep your testimony. Don't let your story go quiet. Someone may only hear of Jesus because you were willing to speak of Christ.

Revelation 12:11 "And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony..."

And as the song declares, and as we can see with our own eyes: Just look around this room, there's nothing God can't do. Pastor Louis
