



Supernatural Life

"All things are possible to the one who believes."
Mark 9:23

Jesus reminds us that faith is a supernatural partnership. It is the meeting place between God's ability and our availability, where His power works through willing hearts. My friend, stay thirsty. Don't give up your appetite for Jesus.

Whenever we talk about miracles, signs, and wonders, some believers hesitate. For whatever reason, many find it easier not to believe than to believe more. It's easier to lower our expectations than to risk disappointment.

But Scripture never calls us to a passive faith. The New Testament builds a compelling case that the miraculous, the intervention of God, is not only possible but normal for the believer's life. Paul boasted in the power of the Spirit (Romans 15:19). The church should never be divided over miracles, but we should be concerned that the lack of visible, tangible supernatural life is becoming the Western church's downfall. A church without demonstration becomes a church without impact.

Some of us believe boldly. Others, because of unanswered prayers, grief, tradition, or our own pain, may find it hard to believe again. That's real, I get it! We all have had moments when we hoped God would break through in a particular way, and that wasn't the case, as far as we know. But the Bible does not teach us to settle. It calls us to believe, to expect, to lean into the supernatural life Jesus promised.

There is always a new day to believe afresh, and that day is today! If ever there was a time for believers to live the supernatural life, it is now. Any church that gives up on signs, wonders, and the impossible does more than lose hope; it misrepresents Jesus.

The world does not need powerless churches explaining God. It needs a church demonstrating His love, His grace, and His Kingdom reality.

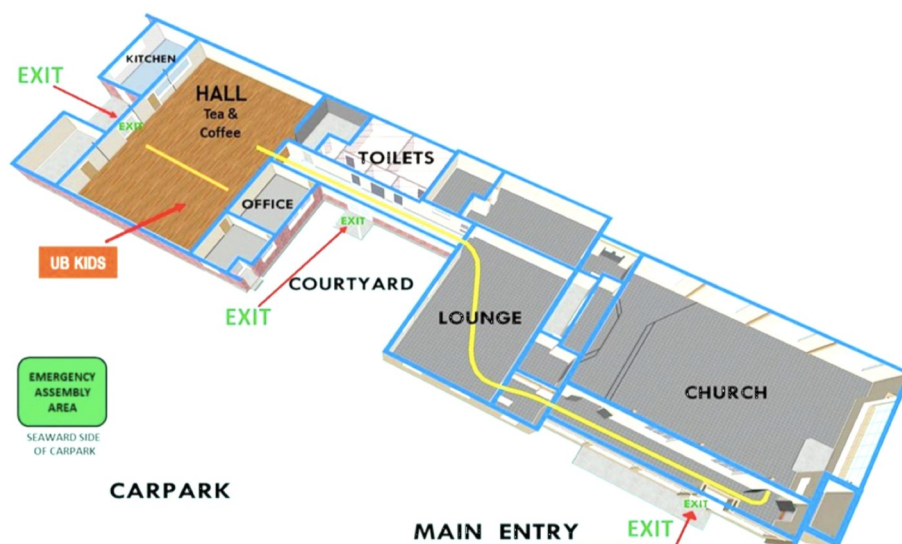

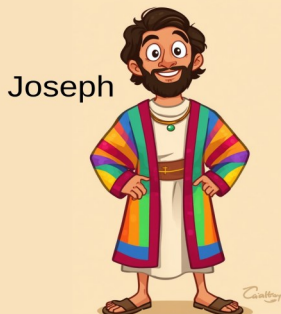

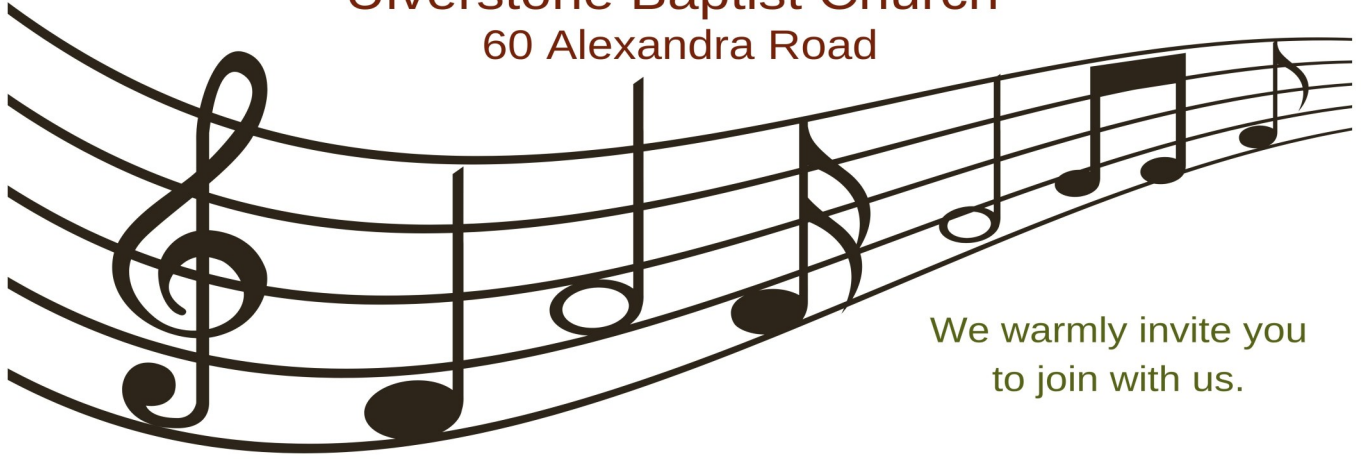
Collect eligible bottles and cans and put them in our collection bin here at UBC in the hall. We will take them to the collection point for you.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER Tracy Valentine, President, Baptist Women of the Pacific

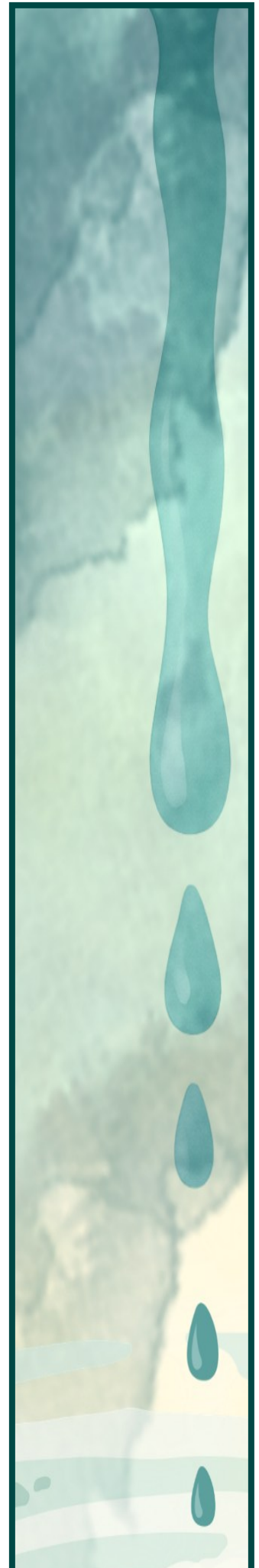
Tracy's life, ministry and career experience is diverse.

Brisbane-based Tracy Valentine recently commenced a four year term as the president of Baptist Women of the Pacific – a network of women's ministries in nations including Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, Papua New Guinea, Papua and West Papua, Tonga and Vanuatu.

The 53-year-old, who is married to Glenn and has three adult children, has long been an advocate for Baptist women and served in a range of church-related roles, including as a pastor (in roles specifically ministering to children and families), as a chaplain, and in state and national roles with the Baptist Church. Tracy currently works as a mission engagement manager – seniors and disability for Carinity, an outreach of Queensland Baptists that provides a range of services, including residential aged care, disability and family support services, and chaplains in hospitals, prisons, and aged care communities.
